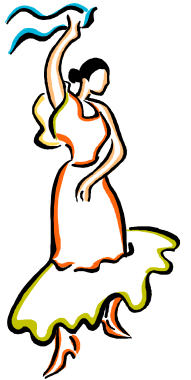

## REGISTRATION

Registration cards will be given to all students and must be filled out, front and back, at the first class.

### New Students:

There will be a \$20.00 registration fee for all new students. This fee is to be paid at the first class. This is a one time only fee. The registration fee proceeds will be used for general studio improvements.

### Continuing Students:

All students continuing their dance education from last year will not be required to pay a registration fee.

## TUITION

Tuition is to be paid at the first class of every month. To better help us track student accounts, please write the student's first and last name in the 'For' location of your check. Tuition payments made in cash should be in a sealed envelope with the student's first and last name written on the outside. A receipt for all cash payments will be given to the student the following week.

Tuition is a monthly fee and is not a cost per class. Tuition will not be higher in months that may have 5 classes, nor will it be lower for months that may have only 3 classes. Corrales Ballet always observes Thanksgiving and winter break. No classes will be held the week of Thanksgiving and the week of winter break. If a student is unable to make a scheduled class due to an extenuating circumstance, like illness, makeup classes are available.

### Tuition Rates:

Standard tuition of \$40.00 is based on 1 class per week (or 4 classes a month). Tuition is not per individual but per immediate family (a family with two students taking 1 class each per week will have a tuition cost of \$65.00). The following is a breakdown of tuition rates:

\$40.00 for 1 class per week  
\$65.00 for 2 classes per week  
\$85.00 for 3 classes per week  
\$105.00 for 4 classes per week

## DRESS CODE

All students in the studio are expected to follow the dress code. The dress code will be discussed in greater detail at the first class. The dress code for each class may vary depending on the style of dance, so please review the following carefully. Also, all dress codes require that hair be up away from the face, no jewelry is to be worn, and class appropriate dance shoes and attire must be worn to participate in class.

- Appropriate dance shoes are required for all dance classes. Dance shoes can be purchased locally at a dance supply store or can be ordered on-line from a dance apparel supplier.
- No jewelry is allowed, with the exception of tight fitting watches and stud earrings. Any jewelry that can dangle or shift while in motion is not permitted.
- Hair must be pulled back away from the face in an appropriate style. If hair is shorter than shoulder length, use barrettes to pull it back.

### Ballet:

- Hair must be up in a bun or in a French braid.
- All students are required to wear ballet shoes. Slippers will not be acceptable as dance shoes because they usually have a slick soles that could lead to injuries.
- All students are expected to wear pink tights and a leotard. Dance skirts or snug fitting, flexible shorts are allowed. Tights should be in pink. Leotard colors are determined by class level and are indicated on the class schedule.

### Tap and Jazz:

- Hair must be up in a ponytail, braid, or French braid.
- All students are required to wear ballet, jazz shoes, dance sneakers, or tap shoes, as appropriate.
- All students are expected to wear Capri dance pants and a semi-tight fitting shirt.

### Flamenco:

- All students are required to wear shoes with a heel and a full, long skirt.

If you have any questions regarding student dress codes or if you would like further information regarding dance suppliers, locally or online, please contact the studio.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The studio asks that no food or drink be brought to class. A water fountain is available in the studio for water breaks. If the student prefers, a water bottle with a closing top is acceptable.

We also ask that students not bring toys from home to class. Toys can cause distractions and disputes among the students. Let's please try to avoid this and leave the toys at home.

### Children NOT participating in class:

A parent should supervise children that are not attending a class at all times. Please keep children within the immediate vicinity of the studio and do not let them wander. The studio staff is responsible for providing dance instruction, not baby-sitting. Parents will be held liable for property damages caused by unattended children. The studio is not responsible for any bodily injuries.
